

### **Numbers 1.**

Read the chapter. Praise the Lord! The Lord tells Moses to number the Army. Each tribe, except the Levites who minister to the Lord for the people, must number their men 20 years and older.

### **Numbers 2.**

Read the chapter. The Lord tells Moses how the tribes are to pitch their tents and how far from the tabernacle. It always surprises me how important it is to obey God.

### **Numbers 3.**

Read the chapter. The Lord tells Moses to number the Levites. The Lord redeems the firstborn of the 12 tribes with money.

### **Numbers 4.**

Read the chapter. The Lord tells Moses to number the Kohathites, the Gershonites and the Merarites. He tells Moses what their duties are with the tabernacle.

### **Numbers 5.**

Read the chapter. The leper (unclean) is removed from the camp. Sin must be confessed before the LORD. The spirit of jealousy sin, which is a murderous spirit, needs confession and an offering and trial.

### **Numbers 6.**

Read the chapter. The Lord told Moses about the Nazarites. These are men and women separated unto the Lord, no drinking nor even eating grapes nor cutting hair. Immediately coming to mind are Samson, Samuel, and John the Baptist. Of women, Samson's mother. How about Jesus, the Nazarene?

### **Numbers 7.**

Read the chapter. I think we should be very wise and notice the generosity of the tribes of Israel to God upon His ministers, the Levi's. In order for us to take the gospel of Jesus Christ to all the world, that same kind of generosity will have to be seen upon Jesus' ministers.

### **Numbers 8.**

Read the chapter. Before the Levites are consecrated for the work of the Lord, the Lord tells Moses how to light the candlestick which represents Jesus, the light of the world. The seven lights are also the seven distinct churches: see **Revelation 1:12**.

### **Numbers 9.**

Read the chapter. A second Passover. The unclean, and the stranger, could partake. Just like Jesus! Praise the Lord: whosoever accepts, whether Jew or Gentile, the Passover Lamb, Jesus, puts His cloud by day and His fire by night over us. His arms are huge!

### **Numbers 10.**

Read the chapter. God introduces the trumpet for every aspect of the Israelites' life: assembly, leadership, alarm, war, gladness, feasts, burnt offerings and over sacrifices. Very soon THE trumpet will sound from Heaven and we which are alive IN CHRIST shall meet in the air those IN CHRIST that arose from their graves. So shall we ever be with the Lord. **1 Thessalonians 4**. The last 7 trumpets will be for the destruction of the wicked and then the 7th and last trumpet will usher in the **Kingdom of God** which shall take over the kingdoms of this world.

**Numbers 11.**

Read the chapter. The people were sick and tired of manna so the Lord sent fire among them and many were consumed. Moses PRAYED and the Lord stopped the fire. But they continued thinking all they had in Egypt: cucumbers, melons, leeks, onions, garlick and they wanted flesh! Moses' burden was too much for him! Moses got 70 men and the Lord shifted the burden from Moses to the 70. But Moses had a hard time believing: *...I am of 600,000 footmen; you have said I will give them flesh, that they may eat a whole month.* God's hand was not short!!! And Moses found that not only did the Lord anoint the 70 and they prophesied but two others did in the camp and God sent a wind that brought quails: two cubics high on the face of their camp to feed millions. So did the plague come because of lust. The wages of sin is death.

**Numbers 12.**

Read the chapter. Moses' brother and sister (of Moses' household, his kin, I emphasize his brother and sister) Aaron and Miriam, spoke against Moses and his wife from Ethiopia. Moses was meek, just as Jesus was, so God fought his battle. No one was going to get away with it, not even kin. Miriam became leprous. Moses prayed, God relented but she was a leper for seven days.

**Numbers 13.**

Read the chapter. God gives Canaan to the Israelites. God GAVE CANAAN to them. There was only a need to see it. But, instead of seeing what God already GAVE, they saw giants. Except for Caleb and Joshua. Do you see Jesus in this chapter? Jesus is coming sooner than we can think to retake Canaan to rule and reign from Jerusalem. Israel had to take it first, present God the Father with the Messiah for the sins of the whole world, and then Jesus retakes it as KING of Kings and LORD of Lords for Israel.

**Numbers 14.** Read the chapter. Fear and unbelief spread in the camp. Except Joshua. He preached. But God had had it with them! Moses, the intercessor, pleaded with God. The price was 40 years in the wilderness; no promised land, except for Joshua and Caleb and those 20 years and younger; and those men that brought up the evil report died instantly. The Amalekites and the Canaanites came against those that were full of unbelief and *smote them, and discomfited them...*

**Numbers 15.**

Read the chapter. As Israel goes on to possess the land, the sacrifice of animals (pointing to Jesus as the final sacrifice) and the sacrifice of flour (Jesus is the Bread of Life) and the sacrifice of oil (pointing to the Holy Spirit) the sacrifice becomes law. There is an offering also for trespassing in ignorance. Also Sabbath-breaking was punishable by stoning. Jesus became our Sabbath!

**Numbers 16.**

Read the chapter. Korah, Dathan and Abiram with 250 men want to *work for the Lord* because they think they can do what Moses did. Moses tells Korah that it wasn't Moses that did the miracles but God. Moses also tells Korah that it is God that CHOOSES His man; the ground opened up and swallowed up the three camps and fire destroyed the 250 men with Korah, Dathan and Abiram. Aaron stayed a plague upon the rest of Israel with prayer.

**Numbers 17.**

Read the chapter. The Lord is hearing murmuring in the Camp. You would think that after seeing the ground open up and swallow Korah, Dathan and Abiram's families and the families of the 250 men that went along with them, and you would think after seeing the fire consuming Korah, Dathan and Abiram and the 250 men with them, the congregation would have known that if you fight Moses, you fight God! Now, you fit Israel, you fight God!

The Lord tells Moses to get 12 rods (like Moses') for each tribe of Israel but instead of putting Levi's name on one of the rods, Aaron's name was put on it. The rods were put in the tabernacle but only Aaron's rod budded, blossomed, and produced almonds. This miracle was seen by the people and they asked Moses whether they were all going to perish! They knew that what they saw was Supernatural, the life of God! Aaron's rod was not a shepherd's rod.

### **Numbers 18.**

Read the chapter. The Lord charges Aaron on his priesthood, and gives the Levites' instructions. Type: Jesus charges His church, blood-bought saints, as His priests and His kings (rulers).

### **Numbers 19.**

Read the chapter. The little red heifer (SHE), without spot and blemish, sacrificed on the altar.

### **Numbers 20.**

Read the chapter. The Lord tells Moses to SPEAK to the ROCK and God's children would have water. But Moses *lifted up his hand, and smote the rock twice... Isaiah 53: 2 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and we hid as it were our faces from Him; He was despised and we esteemed Him not. Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed.*" It is for the reason that Moses SMOTE the Rock that he could not possess the promised land. If only he would have SPOKEN.

In the Christian world, if all you knew was this Scripture, you would never be sick, you would be free from all sin, you would be delivered from all demonic oppression and possession, we would have peace in our heart, never mind a New Mind and a New Heart as a New Creature in Christ Jesus!

### **Numbers 21.**

Read the chapter. The people murmuring are plagued with serpents that bite. The people were sorry that they had followed Moses. They especially disliked manna. I know so many that say they will follow Jesus, but they cannot let go of the house, the car, the bank account, *sell all you have, give to the poor, and Come, follow me*, so they dislike the Bread of Life, Jesus. The people come to Moses in repentance. Type: We now come to Jesus. The Lord tells Moses to make a serpent and put it on the pole. Type: The brass (judgment) serpent on a pole represents Jesus **FULL OF OUR SIN** on the Cross. All that looked up on the brass serpent got healed from the bites. Look up!

### **Numbers 22.**

Read the chapter. All I hear about this chapter is this: if an ass can be used of God, then I too can be used of God. Let it be known that ALL prophets are subject to the Spirit of God, *the word that God puts in my mouth, that shall I speak*. It is impossible to curse that which God has blessed and the children of Israel are a blessed people to have been chosen to bring forth the Messiah, Jesus. Nothing has changed. Bless Israel and you bless God, fight Israel and you fight God.

### **Numbers 23.**

Read the chapter. This is very important. Balak KNEW that Balaam spoke God's word. Balak tried offering Balaam money, prestige and honor if only Balaam would curse Israel from any vantage point he could put Balaam. The devil does not give up; he did the same with Jesus just after Jesus fasted for 40 days. But, Jesus said *It is Written*.

### **Numbers 24.**

Read the chapter. Oil in the lamps continually: the Holy Spirit in us; Jesus said He is the Bread of Life. Blaspheming and cursing the Name of the Lord produces death, then by stoning, and now by the door to heaven being closed.

### **Numbers 25.**

Read the chapter. God's children are now living in Shittim and they inter-marry outside the Holy One of Israel. They now are in devil-worship so God instructs the elders to slay ALL of them. A plague went through the camp, killing 24,000. Phinehas, Aaron's grandson went after a cousin and his Midianite wife and slew them. She was a prince's daughter whose family died in the plague. Like Phinehas, who destroyed the works of the devil, Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil in whosoever will accept Him.

### **Numbers 26.**

Read the chapter. The Lord speaks to Moses and Eleazar to number the 20 year olds and upward men for war and inheritance of the land by tribe, except for Levi, whose family were priests. See **1 Corinthians 9**. ALL the priests receive the tithes and offerings as Abraham gave to Jesus (the Prince of Salem).

### **Numbers 27.**

Read the chapter. Remember Joseph? Well, his son Manasseh's great grand-daughters came to Moses to get an inheritance of land. This act on behalf of all girls changed the law forever. They went to Moses because they were excluded from inheriting land because they were female. Moses went to the Lord. The Lord said that indeed the girls must be included as are boys. The Lord gave other instructions as inheritances go, also. Moses also asks the Lord about his successor. The Lord chooses Joshua. Moses imparts his authority upon Joshua by the laying on of hands in front of the Levi priest, Eleazar.

### **Numbers 28.**

Read the chapter. God is very consistent. Offerings and sacrifices exactly exemplifies the coming Messiah:

Lamb--blood that takes away the sin of the world;

Flour--I am the bread of Life;

Wine--drink this...it is my blood, shed for you;

Oil--Holy Spirit; Young bullocks, ram--

Male; Passover Lamb--**Jesus was crucified at Passover Feast, Joy! Resurrection time!**

### **Numbers 29.**

Read the chapter. Once I heard someone say that the word, God, means *ONE TO BE WORSHIPED*. God, in this chapter, directs Moses to instruct the children of Israel on how to worship Him, whether in burnt offering, drink offering, passover, feast, sin offering, firstfruits; which were all replaced by us worshipping God because of Jesus.

### **Numbers 30.**

Read the chapter.

1. Keep your word with the Lord.
2. A father or an husband, if they hear a woman's vow, can disavow at the time of the vow, but not after.
3. Any woman, widow or divorced, must keep her word; however, in her husband's house or in her father's house, if these vows were uttered, disavowing at the time of the vow but not after, stands. Do you see how God's statute protects a woman?

### **Numbers 31.**

Read the chapter. Before Moses is TAKEN UP to Heaven, God tells Moses that Moses must avenge the children of Israel of the Midianites. One thousand per tribe was sent to war. Twelve thousand destroyed every man including five kings of Midian, and BALAAM. Balaam was told by Balak to curse God's children (remember Balaam beat the donkey; the donkey spoke) Except for single women and children and all animals, everyone was killed. Nothing has changed today. Like the Midianites who refused Israel, the world who refuses Israel (Jesus) now will be destroyed; whosoever accepts Him will have LIFE!

### **Numbers 32.**

Read the chapter. Rueben and Gad make a deal with Moses. They will fight until ALL their brothers inherit Canaan. In this chapter, Manasseh, Joseph's son, has his inheritance.

### **Numbers 33.**

Read the chapter. God reiterates geography and history. Aaron, 123 years age, dies at Mount Hor. God also warns Moses that they must dispossess the inhabitants of the land for He gave the land of Canaan to the children of Israel.. Verse **55** *But, if you will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you; then it shall come to pass, that those which you let remain of them shall be pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall vex you in the land wherein you dwell. Moreover it shall come to pass, that I shall do to you as I thought to do unto them.* King Jesus, the Messiah, will straighten Canaanland out when He comes back.

### **Numbers 34.**

Read the chapter. *Rueben, Gad and Manasseh have their inheritance on the east side of the Jordan River; the rest of the land of Canaan is given to the nine tribes and the half tribe of Manasseh: (this is the land that shall fall unto you for an inheritance, even the land of Canaan with the coasts thereof:) Then your SOUTH quarter shall be from the wilderness of Zin along by the coast of Edom, and your south border shall be the outmost coast of the salt sea eastward. And your border shall turn from the south to the ascent of Akrabbim, and pass on to Zin: and the going forth thereof shall be from the south to Kadesh-barnea, and shall go on to Hazar-addar, and pass on to Azmon: And the border shall fetch a compass from Azmon unto the river of Egypt, and the goings out of it shall be at the sea. And as for the WESTERN border you shall even have the great sea for a border: this shall be your west border. And this shall be your NORTH border: from the great sea you shall point out for you Mount Hor: From Mount Hor you shall point out your border unto the entrance of Hamath; and the goings forth of the border shall be to Zedad: And the border shall go on to Ziphron, and the goings out of it shall be at Hazar-enan: this shall be your north border. And you shall point out your EAST border from Hazar-enan to Shepham: And the coast shall go down from Shepham to Riblah, on the east side of Ain; and the border shall descend, and shall reach unto the side of the sea of Chinnereth eastward: And the border shall go down to Jordan, and the goings out of it shall be at the salt sea: this shall be your land with the coasts thereof round about. And Moses commanded the children of Israel, saying. **This is the land***

*which you shall inherit by lot, which the Lord commanded to give unto the nine tribes, and to the half tribe...* NOTHING HAS CHANGED!

**Numbers 35.**

Read the Chapter. The priests, the Levites, are given 48 cities with their suburbs for their inheritance. Six of the cities shall be cities of refuge for the children of Israel and for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them: that every one that kills any person unawares may flee thither. The Levites judged. But one witness is not enough, two or more witnesses against the murderer is needed.

**Numbers 36.**

Read the Chapter. Tribes cannot take each other's property. The half tribe of Manasseh's property (Joseph) was delegated to five daughters. Mahlah (prayer, weakness) Tirzah (pleased with, delight in) Hoglah (house, family) Milcah (royal) Noah (continual). Doesn't that describe our walk in Jesus?
